Candidate for a PHD Application Normative and Regulatory challenges in the field of European Pensions

The "Pension Chair" at the Law Faculty and the Institute for interdisciplinary research in Legal Sciences of UCLOUVAIN (Louvain-La-Neuve) looks for a PhD candidate for a doctoral research in Law.

The candidate will be associated to a FSR research project submitted in January 2017 with a final decision taken in may 2017. If the budget is granted, the candidate will be hired for a 2 scholarship of 2 years' renewable with a maximum of four years. The remuneration package, includes a monthly allowance, social security and insurance expenses, and funding of research related activities (participation to conferences and research missions related to the project).

The candidate is expected to develop a doctoral research in the field of Pension Law from a "social security law", a "financial law", a "European law", a "comparative law" and/or an "economic law" perspective.

The candidate must have a university degree (master) in Law. He is expected to show evidence of strong academic credentials and an ability for research. Good French and English language skills are required. The mastery of Dutch is a trump. International experiences and publications are strongly appreciated.

The project will be made in partnership with a research team in Pension financing and funding. An interest for trans-disciplinarily method is thus required.
